- First episode psychosis program
- Symptoms Associated with Psychosis
 - Hallucinations (Audio, Voices, Visual, Smell or taste)
 - Delusions/Ideas of Reference
 - Confused Thinking and other Cognitive Deficits
 - Decline of Social Functioning
 - Disorganized Behavior and/or speech
 - Depression
 - Negative Symptoms (Lack of energy, motivation, expressiveness)
- Psychosis describes conditions that affect the mind causing a loss of contact with reality or trouble deciding on what is real and what is not real.
- Nearly 3.5% of all people will experience psychosis in their lifetime.
- The 3rd most disabling condition in the world.
- New Journeys Model
 - Personalized therapy
 - Support and education for families
 - Employment educational support
 - Symptom and stress management
 - Peer counseling

- Help with medications
- This model was brought to Washington in 2015.
- Admission Criteria
 - Age 15-40
 - Resident of Snohomish County
 - Psychotic symptoms have been present between 1 week and 2 years
 - Primary diagnosis of one of the following
 - Schizophrenia
 - Schizoaffective Disorder
 - Schizophreniform Disorder
 - Brief psychotic Disorder
 - Delusional Disorder
 - Other specified psychotic Disorder
 - All insurances are accepted including unfunded.
- Psychosis is not known to be caused by a diagnosis of a mood disorder, developmental disorder, autism, substance intoxication and or withdrawal or a medical condition.
